Importance of Class Dojo



Class Dojo is an online reward program.

Class Dojo consists of three parts: the teacher, the parent and the student. The teacher encourages students, engage parents through Class Dojo Messaging, encourage skills in the classroom, and reflect on progress.

Students get a good overview of the effect of their behavior and know exactly when they do or don't do something right. For their individual development, this option is most obvious. Parents can get involved, connect with teachers, and celebrate the child's progress and educational growth. Kids can celebrate with their parents, create their own avatar and see their strengths.

Parents are asked to communicate by Class Dojo with the class teacher/ subject teacher.

Action plan Sr. Magda school 2024 2025

This school year the focus is on following actions:

- ensuring quality in education (differentiating and didactics so that there is maximum learning going on with the students).
- ensuring adequate support in the social emotional development of our PEARLS.
- increasing the involvement of parents in the various activities at school such as Reading Parents (reading with children in Dutch and English).
- collaboration with the PIT (Parent Involvement Team) Sr. Magda school.
- This school year we want to fundraise enough to invest it back into our schoollibrary

We will do various activities such as:

- Wacky days, Math Day, Taal Dag, Taal Dorp, Proefjes dag, Science Fair, Sports Day, Educational Tours, Mass Days, Kinder Boeken week, Christmas Raffle, Christmas celebration, Fundraisings activities with the PIT. You will be kept informed about these activities.

Teaching curriculum

At the Sr. Magda School, we work with the concept of Experience Oriented Education. Here the students are challenged to work from their experience. We also apply inquiry-based design learning where students search for information themselves. teachers work in the classroom with cooperative forms of work. For this we use the school yard, our learning squares and our digital platforms (Gynzy). We also have BYOD (Bring your own Device) from grades 5-8).

Music: this school year, grades 5 through 8 will be taught with the recorder. Also, grade 7 will have Steelpan lessons.

Sr. Magda singing choir: for this school year our group 7 has been chosen as the singing choir for the Church. Mr. Gregory comes once a week to practice with the students. The Keyboard is also used here.

Catholic faith: every week on the Monday, the students have weekly opening together with their teachers. during this meeting the Catholic faith is discussed, also the theme is discussed. Singing and prayer is part of this. The students prepare this together with their teachers. Performances will be done by the Stage.
